

Quick Facts: The Inaugural Rockford Boxing Classic

What You Need to Know About This Saturday's Premier Outdoor Boxing Event

ROCKFORD, Ill., August 9, 2022: The inaugural **Rockford Boxing Classic** is set for this Saturday, August 13, at Rockford City Market's outdoor pavilion in downtown Rockford. A joint production of Plus Seven Company and Rockford Patriots Boxing Club, the Rockford Boxing Classic will feature area youth and first responder boxers competing for city pride as part of an all-ages micro-festival.

Gates open at 5 p.m. when music, food and beverages will be available. The action gets started with youth bouts at 6 p.m. followed by a first responder match-up at approximately 8 p.m. Here is what guests can expect when attending the Rockford Boxing Classic:

- Rockford Boxing Excellence: The Rockford Boxing Classic bout line-up features some of the Rockford Patriots Boxing Club's and Midwest's top boxers, including three-time Silver Gloves national champion Gavin Bernal and top prospect and future pro Osiel Flores. In addition, USA Boxing national team member Braulio Arcos-Rodriguez of the Rockford Patriots Boxing Club will also be in attendance.
- The Return of Angel Martinez: National Golden Gloves champion and world-ranked boxer Angel Martinez is slated to return to the ring for the first time in four years. In addition to his numerous national championships and world youth boxing recognitions, Martinez, a 2018 Auburn High School graduate, was named USA Boxing's 2017 Under Armour Youth Male Boxer of the Year.
- Rockford Police Represent: Rockford police officer Cory Magnuson, who has tallied a 2-1-1 amateur mixed martial arts record, will lace up the gloves in one of the night's featured bouts. Known for his community work having served as a ROCK House officer, Magnuson has also trained area youth during program partnerships at Rockford Patriots Boxing Club.
- Free Admission: Bring your own lawn chair—general admission is free!
