

Rockford Boxing Classic Returns Saturday to Downtown Rockford

Gates Open at 4 p.m. Saturday at City Market for Free Admission Boxing Festival

ROCKFORD, Ill., August 10, 2023: The second annual **Rockford Boxing Classic** returns this Saturday, August 12, at Rockford City Market's outdoor pavilion in downtown Rockford. As the region's premier outdoor boxing event, the Rockford Boxing Classic (RBC) will feature some of the Midwest's top youth boxers and a Police-vs.-Fire-themed main event.

A production of the nonprofit Rockford Patriots Boxing Club and Plus Seven Company, gates open at 4 p.m. when music, local food and beverage sales, and all-ages entertainment begins. Boxing action gets started at 5 p.m. with a variety of boys and girls bouts—including many local youth who compete for the Rockford Boxing Club—before capping off the night with the Police vs. Fire heavyweight main event.

"We're excited to be back for year two and to see the continued growth of the Rockford Boxing Classic," said **Jimmy Goodman**, club director of the Rockford Patriots Boxing Club. "This is a free community event that showcases some of the region's most talented youth boxers who compete locally and nationally. It's also a great way for us to engage the community by featuring the Rockford Police and Fire Departments – we can't wait for Saturday night!"

Attendees of the Rockford Boxing Classic will experience the following program highlights:

- Rockford Boxing Club Excellence: The Rockford Boxing Classic bout line-up features some of the Midwest's and Rockford Patriots Boxing Club's top boxers, including Gavin Bernal (No. 2 nationally in USA Boxing 119 Division, invitee to 2023 USA Boxing Junior Training Camp in Chula Vista, CA) and Julian Lugo (Junior Golden Gloves National Champion, Chicago Golden Gloves Champion).
- Battle of the Badges: In the main event, James "Champ" Nachampassack of the Rockford Police Department will face Ryan Taylor of the Rockford Fire Department in a sanctioned USA Boxing heavyweight bout. This marks the second-straight year that the Rockford Police Department has fielded a boxer in the Rockford Boxing Classic (Rockford Police officer Cory Magnuson won his bout in 2022), while Taylor's appearance Saturday will mark the Rockford Fire Department's RBC debut.
- Free Admission: If you didn't purchase a table, bring your lawn chair general admission is FREE!
- Win the 50/50 Raffle!: 50/50 raffle ticket sales (cash only) will be located at the Rockford Patriots Boxing Club tent, and the 50/50 raffle winner will be announced before the main event!
- Tacos, Corn, Fruit, Treats & Drinks: Guests can purchase local food from Jaliscoast Rayo and Lulu's Roasted Corn, as well as sweet treats from TNT Funnel Cakes. Support local!
